

# University College Cork Program Budget

## Fall Semester, 2010

**Dates (to be confirmed): Late August to early December, 2010**

The following are budget guidelines and estimates for student expenses while enrolled at the University College Cork, Ireland for the period of study of approximately 16 weeks. The amounts listed have been converted from Euros to U.S. dollars. ### Program Costs to be paid to Wheaton College:

- Wheaton Tuition and Wheaton Housing

Students are not charged Wheaton technology, laundry, or the student activities fees while on a study abroad program. Fees will be billed to students on their regular Wheaton College Student Account during regular billing cycles (July for Fall semester & December for Spring semester). Questions about payment schedules and financial aid should be directed to the Office of Student Financial Services (ext. 8232).

### Confirmation Deposit:

All students accepted to a study abroad program will be assessed a **\$500 non-refundable confirmation deposit** at the time of final confirmation of study abroad participation. Once enrolled, this deposit is applied to your Wheaton Student Account toward Wheaton tuition and fees for the study abroad program. More information can be found at:
