### Program Costs to be paid to Wheaton College:

- Wheaton Tuition
- Wheaton Housing

Students are not charged the technology, laundry, or the student activities fee while on a study abroad program.

Fees will be billed to students on their regular Wheaton College student account during regular billing cycles (July for Fall semester & December for Spring semester).

### Confirmation Deposit:

All students accepted to a study abroad program will be assessed a **\$500 non-refundable confirmation deposit** at the time of final confirmation of study abroad participation. Once enrolled, this deposit is applied to your Wheaton Student Account toward Wheaton tuition and fees for the study abroad program.
